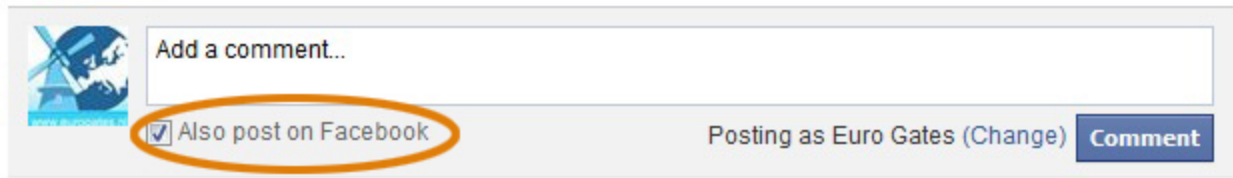


Instructions for participants of the Eurogates “Dutch Education Review” Survey



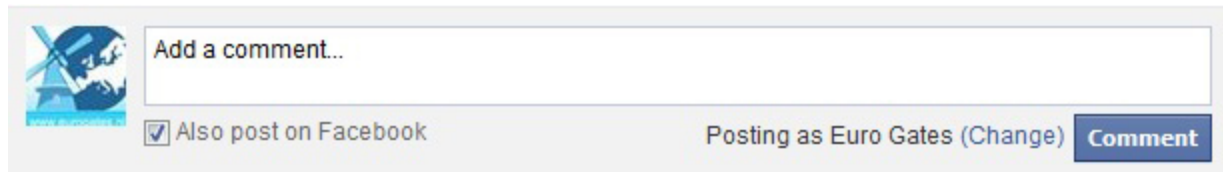
How to submit your answers:
